If you answered...

Navigation Services— Helping people connect to healthcare—physicians, nurse practitioners, dentists, mental health providers—as well as to diagnostic and treatment services; assistance with transportation to out-of-county services; over 2,000 county residents served

Breast Cancer Support—Assistance in accessing cancer resources and education; twice annual mammography van screenings in Park County; over 250 mammograms to date through this service

Health Insurance—Connect for Health Colorado—RMRH offers **FREE** assistance in finding a healthcare plan. We have the only two certified Health Coverage guides in the county.

Families in Crisis Fund—Emergency assistance to help families in need due to the financial impact of a medical condition.

Sports Physicals—One day event each year providing free or low cost sports physicals for students grade school through high school. Keeping kids active and learning the positive lessons of being part of a team.

Llama Rama—promoting the Colorado Organ Donor Registry; the longest running organ donor awareness event in Colorado—held every July during Burro Days. In Colorado there are 2736 people awaiting a life saving organ transplant. Nationwide 122,302 are on the waiting list.

Assisting the Disabled—Connecting people with disabilities to resources and helping our community respond to their special needs.

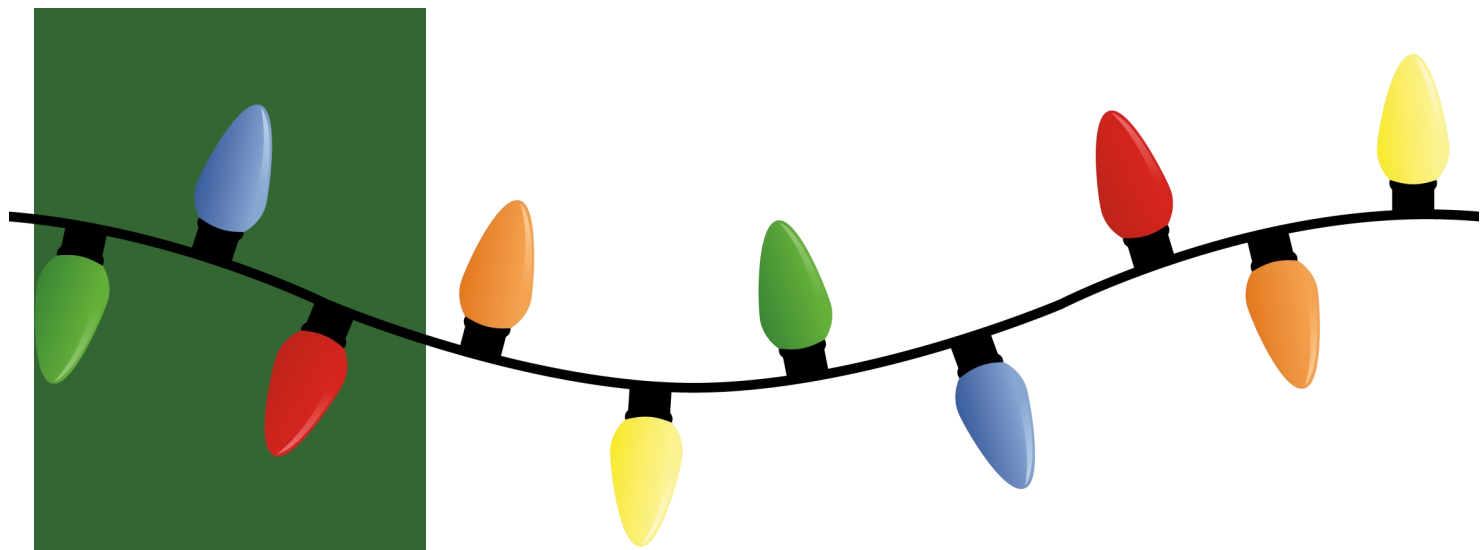

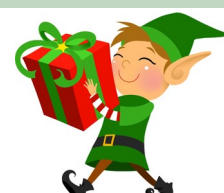
